A VISIT TO DEAF & DUMB SCHOOL

“Deafness isn’t the opposite of hearing...it’s a silence of sound.”

There was a visit to the deaf and dumb school “Welfare centre for persons with speech and hearing impairment”, Gurugram on 16th November 2018. All the students of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. along with the faculty members had observed the problems of students, the methods of teaching and learning and other various issues.

The centre is devoted towards the cause of education, skill development and empowerment of more than 300 deaf students. The latest possible equipments are used for teaching purpose. The education curriculum and syllabus taught is at par with the syllabus taught in other schools upto the High school standard and is taught by the specially trained teachers. The local civil hospital is actively involved in general health check up of the students. For the out-station boys and girls, the centre maintains two hostels for different age groups. Apart from the studies and curricular activities, the centre is also focused to enhance the overall wellbeing of the students and organises various events on regular basis to enhance children's mental, social and physical growth and ensure overall nourishment of the students.

A computer-cum-placement center has been established to impart vocational and skills training and to provide suitable placements to the special children. The centre follows the wholesome approach focused at the social integration of its deaf students and has started a unique programme for parents, siblings and family members to learn Sign language so that the communication barrier can be removed. The centre has pioneered in creating Digital Sign Language Lab which would be a great contribution for the students.



EXTENSION LECTURES & WORKSHOPS



As a regular feature of the college activities, an extension lecture was organized on 24th October 2018. Dr. Renu Bala Nandal, Assistant Professor, C.R. College of Education, Rohtak delivered an interesting, meaningful and thought provoking lecture on **“Skills of micro teaching & lesson planning”**. The lecture was attended by the faculty members and students.

The lecture focused on sharpening and developing specific micro

teaching skills and lesson planning. The lecture aimed at concept of micro teaching; various skills of micro teaching; importance of lesson planning in daily life & basic steps involved in a lesson plan. TRAINING PROGRAMME

“With practical education, we endow our students with hands-on skills and experience for them to function proactively in their future careers”.

Practical training or internship allows students to acquire the practical knowledge and abilities offered by the professional world which they wish to be a part of, and at the same time to be more skillful and confident. **M.Ed. (first sem.)** students were sent for internship programme to various education colleges in Gurugram for 21 working days in the month of December 2018. To impart the practical knowledge of teaching to **B.Ed. (first year)** students, micro teaching and mega teaching were conducted for 15 days in simulated conditions. Subject specific demonstration lessons were presented by the respective faculty to minimise the complexities of future teachers. **B.Ed. (second year)** students participated in the school internship programme (SIP) for 16 weeks & 2 weeks for school experience programme (SEP) where they practiced the real teaching and made school based activity reports. **D.El.Ed. (second year)** students were sent for School internship programme (SIP) for 12 weeks in the Govt. schools of Gurugram .



EXAMINATION "THE NECESSARY EVIL"

Examination plays a vital role in one's educational career. It evaluates the student's knowledge, skill and proficiency in a subject. Mock exams let students practice revision strategies that are proven to be more helpful and discover what works best for them.
